87th Annual Pacific Rose Society Show on April 26-27, 2025



Pacific Rose Society is proud to announce our 87th Annual Rose Show, and all rose enthusiasts across the District are invited to attend this premier rose event. We are all excited to get together once again with our fellow rosarians in the Spring to celebrate our National Flower, the Rose.

The Pacific Rose Society's annual show will once again be held in the spacious Ayers Hall at the Los Angeles County Arboretum on Saturday, April 26, 2025. No registration will be required, since this is not a District Show. This fabulous rose show is always an outstanding event. It features a huge show schedule which contains at least 77 classes for Hybrid Teas, Floribundas, Miniatures, Minifloras, Microminiatures, Modern Shrubs, Classic Shrubs, Climbers and Old Garden Roses. Special classes include "Rose in a Bowl" and "English Box" categories for Hybrid Teas, Floribundas, Shrubs, Old Garden Roses, Climbers, Miniatures and Minifloras. This is a rare opportunity for exhibitors to showcase all these different types of roses in a variety of different formats. The schedule also includes a wide variety of Challenge Classes. The show will also include 14 Arrangement classes with a patriotic theme plus a large Photography division.



The preparation area at the Arboretum opens for exhibitors at 6:00 a.m. at the Arboretum. Entries will be received from 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m., but entry deadline may be extended at the discretion of the show chairman.

The Show opens to the public at 1:00 p.m. Awards and Certificates will be presented at the completion of judging on Saturday, April 26th. Entries must remain in place until Sunday, April 27th. Bouquets of roses, a variety of K&M roses, and Grow More fertilizer will be available for sale on Saturday and Sunday. The Rose Show closes to the public on Sunday afternoon at 3:00 p.m.



Show participants and attendees will also have the opportunity to wine and dine along restaurant row on Huntington Drive, shop at Armstrong Garden Centers, and tour the lovely Arboretum and Botanical Gardens in Arcadia, all the while visiting with rose friends from around the District.
