Description: Light lavender exhibition blooms with deep lavender edging. Semi-glossy medium green foliage. Not in commerce. Very hard to find variety.



Debora Moncrief

Hybridizer: J. Ben Williams

Description: Large full pink blend with cream blooms have 26-40 petals. Medium, bushy, spreading growth that is almost thornless. Large matte dark green foliage. Strong fragrance. This is a RARE hard to find rose from the John Bagnasco Collection.



Hey Jack

Type: Hybrid Tea (from K&M Roses on Fortuniana)

Introduced: 2010

Hybridizer: Frank & Barbara Wright

Description: Yellow blend exhibition form blooms with touches of orange and pink. Flowers have 26-40 petals with an average diameter of 5". Semi-glossy medium green foliage and an upright growth habit to 5' tall. Excellent disease resistance. Will exhibit. Large plant on fortuniana rootstock.



Kleopatra

Description: Striking color combination of red and yellow blend exhibition form blooms with a yellow-brass reverse. Large flowers have about 41 petals and an average diameter of 4.25". Large glossy dark green foliage. This is a hard to find rose. RARE ROSE from the John Bagnasco Collection.



Millie Perkins

Hybridizer: G. Maarse in the Netherlands

Description: Large double red blend blooms have between 17-25 petals.
Medium green matte foliage.

Eligible for Classic Hybrid Tea class in rose shows.

Description: Orange-red blooms have a carmine-red reverse and up to 26 petals. Medium, very double, cupped bloom form. Glossy, dark green foliage. Eligible for Classic Hybrid Tea class in rose shows.

Morocco

Type: Hybrid Tea

Hybridizer: Gordon J. Von Abrams

Description: Large deep red double blooms have about 30 petals, an average diameter of 5" and high-centered bloom form. Medium green glossy foliage on an upright, vigorous grower. Strong fragrance.
Eligible for Classic Hybrid Tea class in rose shows.

Mrs. Miniver

Type: Hybrid Tea

Hybridizer: Cesar Chambard in France

Description: Very large scarlet red blooms are crimson with a darker reverse. Flowers have up to 20 petals with an average diameter of 5.5" and a cupped bloom form. Reddish-purple foliage. Strong fragrance. RARE hybrid tea that was recently rediscovered. Eligible for Classic Hybrid Tea class in rose shows. From John Bagnasco Collection.



Mystery Yellow HT – Possibly Aunt Gerry

Description: Originally from K&M Roses. Lost tag. Golden yellow blooms have about 35 petals. Mild spice fragrance. Hard to find rose. Capable of exhibition form but makes a better garden rose.

Description: White exhibition form blooms have deep carmine-pink edging and up to 30 petals. Fruity fragrance. Semi-glossy medium green foliage.
Hard to find rose from John Bagnasco Collection.

Description: Light pink classic hybrid tea. Semi-glossy medium green foliage.
Eligible for Classic Hybrid Tea class at rose shows.

Description: Uniquely colorful rose of russet double blooms that are a blend of smokey lavender and rusty red with 17-25 petals and an average diameter of 3.5". Medium glossy dark green foliage. Continuous repeat blooming rose. Flowers resist fading and disease resistance is strong. ARS Members Choice winner and AARS Winner.

Dark glossy green foliage. Grows well on its own roots. Very hard to find. Excellent show rose that is now out of commerce.

Description: Single light pink sport of Playgirl has 4-7 petals and an average diameter of 3". Semi-glossy medium green foliage. Strong fragrance. Excellent for exhibition.

Description: Medium red double blooms are mildly fragrant.

Tall grower. Give it lots of room.

Description: Deep golden yellow English rose with old-fashioned rosette bloom form. Roses have 110-120 petals and an average diameter of 2.75". Lightly fragrant. Large, leathery medium green semi-glossy foliage. Almost thornless.

Description: Striking pink blooms with crimson stripes have cupped bloom form and about 25 petals. Large, matte green foliage. Moderate fragrance. Very disease resistant.

Description: Deep pink sport of Five Yuan with four petals. Medium, matte green foliage. There are only six plants of this rose in existence.

Leda

Hybridizer: Unknown English Breeder

Description: Exquisite white blend blooms with reddish purple edging have exquisitely beautiful old-fashioned form with the much sought-after button eyes. Known as a once-bloomer, it will occasionally repeat later in the season. Dark green foliage. Strong old rose fragrance.



Souvenir du President Lincoln

Type: Bourbon

Introduced: 1865

Hybridizer: Robert Moreau in France

Description: Deep pink to crimson old-fashioned blooms have about 80 petals. Named to honor President Lincoln in the year of his death. Medium, matte green foliage. Strong fragrance. *** RARE collector's rose.



Velours Episcopal

Type: Hybrid China

Introduced: 1908

Hybridizer: Modeste Guerin (Angers) in France

Description: Mauve blend blooms of violet purple/pink are presented in clusters. Flowers are medium to large with a flat, scalloped bloom form a 3.25" diameter and 26-40 petals. Blooms once in spring or summer. Moderate fragrance. Medium, matte green foliage. RARE collector's rose.



Yolande d'Aragon

Introduced: 1943

Hybridizer: Jean-Pierre Vibert in France

Description: Mauve blend to deep pink cupped blooms have 26-40 petals that are 3" in diameter. Medium, matte green foliage.

Strong fragrance. Good disease resistance. Top exhibition rose.

Description: Orange blend flowers blooming in large clusters have 17-25 petals with an average diameter of 2.25". Medium, semi-glossy, light green foliage. Drought resistant and disease resistant. Hard to find variety.

Description: Rose-pink sport of Orange Triumph has 17-25 petals and blooms in large clusters. Dark green semi-glossy foliage.

Description: White blend polyantha with pink blush having rosette blooms with 17-25 petals and a diameter of 1.75". Short, bushy, almost thornless plant. Very disease resistant and shade tolerant.

Description: Light pink decorative miniature, sometimes showing white edging, is thought to be a sport of Marriotta. It produces blooms with an average diameter of 1.5" and 26-40 petals. Medium green matte foliage on a nearly thornless plant. Plant grows to about 20" tall. RARE, hard to find rose.



Bee's Knees (2 Plants)

Description: Yellow blend blooms with blushes of orange and pink. Blooms have exhibition form, 26-40 petals and average diameter of 2.5".

Dark green matte foliage is very disease resistance. Easy care rose.

One of the best miniatures for exhibition. Miniature Hall of Fame.

Abundant blooms of pale cream to golden yellow with a soft pink blush give a deceptively fragile appearance to these fragrant flowers.

The rose has a mild, fruity scent. Medium, semi-glossy dark green foliage.

Heat tolerant and shade tolerant, although it prefers full sun.

Very disease resistant.
